# **Bills in the Scottish Parliament**

This month members of the Scottish Parliament voted on the introduction of four important new Bills:

- Stage 1 and Stage 3 of the Scottish Budget 2024/25
- Stage 1 Bankruptcy & Diligence (Scotland) Bill
- Stage 1 Regulation of Legal Services (Scotland) Bill
- Stage 1 National Care Service (Scotland) Bill

I was pleased to be able to speak in Stage 1 of the Scottish Budget and Stage 1 of the Regulation of Legal Services debates.

Decades of economic vandalism from successive UK Governments compounded to make this the most challenging budget of recent years. Despite this, the Scottish Government produced a fair and progressive budget that reflects our shared values as a nation and speaks to the kind of Scotland that we want to be. I look forward to the other Bills progressing through the Parliamentary process, and will contribute wherever possible in their debates.


